The 1st point was scored by Ciarán Kilkenny on his way to a man of the match performance. Shane Boland scored 2 points from frees. Castleknock's 1st goal was scored by Cian Ó Dúlaing.

Ballyboden scored their 1st and only goal of the match inspite of a strong Castleknock defence.

Eoghan Quinn scored a lovely point and Shane Maher scored Castleknock's second goal of the match, following great work from Jack Kiernan, and Stephen Donaldson, supported by Shane Butler in attack.

The quick and skilful Ian Cleary covered acres of the pitch from half back, and added a point of his own in that time. Ciarán Kilkenny in outstanding form, added another five points form play.

The defence ruled the second half. With great performances from Ross Mullins, Conor Prunty, Graham Hannigan, and Ronan Prunty. Midfield too played their part in the defence with Shane and Ciarán always available to help out. The halfbacks of the afore mentioned Ian Cleary and Ray McDermott stuck to their task with great consistency, and continued to provide the best of ball to the forwards.

One of these was picked up by Kevin Kindlon, who ran hard at the Ballyboden defence before deftly smashing the ball into the corner of the net. Eoghan Quinn followed up again with a good point.

Castleknock made a switch in the forwards, bringing Martin Brady on for Shane Butler. Martin applied his considerable frame to do a marking job on the Ballyboden centre back, a job which he carried out superbly well until the end of the match. Although they did manage to score some fine points during this time, they found the goal of Conor O'Reilly impenetrable. Conor, who has worked very hard on his game this year, made a couple of blinding saves in the second half to prove that point.

Subsequent to our championship victory, we are also League Hurling Champions for 2006.
