Friday 25th August saw the conclusion of what has been another successful summer camp programme in Castleknock Hurling and Football Club.

Generously sponsored again by SPAR Carpenterstown our camps seem to go from strength to strength. This year our programme consisted of 4 standard camps and 2 schools of excellence.

Nearly 330 of our juvenile members attended our camps this year, most of whom attended more than one camp.

This year saw some more new ideas: The Nursery Camp which allowed the youngest of our members to avail of our camps and The School of Excellence for our senior members, which was a more serious intensive camp with greater emphasis on physical fitness and conditioning. By all accounts this was a resounding success which looks like being a permanent feature of our camp programmes in the future. The emphasis on well being and diet was also present in our regular camps. Thanks to the generous support of the National Dairy Council we were able to provide milk everyday to each child, we distributed information leaflets on diet, hosted presentations from nutritionists and ran a quiz competition to encourage our kids to learn about the importance of nutrition.

The emphasis on skills and mastery of the game was also ever present. Under the direction of our Games Promotion Officer Daire O'Neill our coaching team put the kids through their paces everyday in an enjoyable and fun way. Kids were rewarded at the end of each day for the effort and improvement they made through our daily merit awards. Then at the end of each camp there were medals for each team and then there were overall awards for the most improved players in each age group. Of course everyone then went home with a 'goodie bag' things for the kids to enjoy and play with
